RE: Mendocino Town trash receptacles

Dear Juliana:

I would appreciate it if you would notify the Mendocino Historical Review Board that I am hoping to fix some of the problems with the sidewalk trash receptacles. On behalf of the County of Mendocino, MSWMA added many of the oak barrels for this purpose. However, they haven't worked out well because:


1. The top openings have no protection from rain or birds.
2. The metal lids are often removed, displaced or missing.

MSWMA is supposed to receive a state grant of approximately \$31,000 later this spring to be used for recycling promotional purposes. With the approval of the MSWMA Board of Commissioners, I will propose to use this grant to purchase new metal sidewalk trash receptacles for Mendocino.

The design I propose is somewhat similar to the side-door metal units already in the town, but different in that there is a lid to protect against rain and birds. The enclosed photo shows one possible unit. It is shown in green but is also available in black.

Review of this plan by the Historical Review Board would be welcome.



