### July 1, 2014 – June 30, 2015

Per the DOL Employment and Training Administration (ETA, “The Adult and Dislocated Worker Program, Under Title I of the Workforce Investment Act of 1998, is designed to provide quality employment and training services to assist individuals in finding and qualifying for meaningful employment and to help employers find the skilled workers they need to compete and success in business.”

As the program provider for WIA Adult and Dislocated Workers MPIC’s goal is to promote an increase in employment, job retention, earnings and occupational skills improvement for eligible job seekers. This, in turn, improves the quality of the workforce, reduces welfare dependency, and improves the productivity and competitiveness for our Community.

<b>PROGRAM SERVICES DEFINITION</b>
<b>CORE SERVICES:</b> Outreach, job development, job referrals, job search & placement, workshops, labor market information for all job seekers and eligibility determination for intensive services for those enrolled in the WIA program.
<b>INTENSIVE SERVICES:</b> Comprehensive & specialized assessments of skill levels & service needs, development of an employment plan, & short-term pre-vocational services. Eligibility determination for training services for those enrolled in the WIA Program
<b>TRAINING SERVICES:</b> Training services include occupational skills training, entrepreneurial training, job readiness training, Adult education and literacy, On-the-Job training, customized training and skills upgrade and retraining.
