SUBJECT: Ramp Removal at Main and Kasten Streets adjacent to Jarvis-Nichols Building

On September 14, 2015 the Mendocino County Department of Transportation (MCDOT) removed a non-conforming ramp from the right-of-way at the corner of Kasten Street and Main Street in the town of Mendocino. As a temporary safety measure, due to the elevated height of the concrete patio which has functioned as a public pedestrian walkway, a railing has been installed.

The building owner has inquired about a new ramp system and MCDOT has met with the owner to discuss an encroachment permit. Until then pedestrians need to follow the paths around (up Kasten to Albion and back down Kasten) to avoid the elevation change at the corner of Main and Kasten.

MCDOT will work with the building owner or any applicant on a solution that meets current standards.
