REQUEST: Use Permit to establish a Cottage Industry –Custom Manufacturing, artist collective studio. The use will be conducted within a newly constructed 1,000 square foot workshop with paved access to the workshop from the existing driveway.

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: Class 3(e) Categorical Exemption pursuant to Section 15303 for new construction of accessory structures, like garages, carports, patios or workshops.

LOCATION: 3± miles Southeast of Fort Bragg, lying east of Mitchell Creek Drive (CR 414B) just north of its intersection with Turner Road (CR 414F) and Franklin Road (CR 414D), located at 16551 Mitchell Creek Drive; APN 019-450-24.
