REQUEST: Use Permit to allow Caltrans to maintain a Maintenance Disposal Facility on a 1.32± acre site with a 44± acre parcel. The project will consist of site preparation, placing, storing, recycling and compacting of fill material (rock and soil, up to 15,000 cubic yard over a 5 year period) collected from on-going maintenance activities of state highways.
LOCATION: In Yorkville, lying southwest of Highway 128, just northwest of its intersection with Elkhorn Road (CR 120), located at 26800 HWY 128; APN 049-290-19.
